

# R5 Technical Training

This course is designed for SDL Tridion R5 programmers who need to understand and work with the product API, Object Model and product components such as Content Publishing, Deployment, Delivery and Linking.

## Training curriculum overview

We designed our SDL Tridion Training Curriculum to help our customers build their R5 skills. The curriculum is designed to provide training for both new customers (Standard) and existing customers that migrate to R5 (Delta). We offer a specific training track for each role within an SDL Tridion project.

The training tracks we offer consist of a Standard Training course, which includes R5 Technical Training, Delta courses, and specialized Master Classes for those who are experienced using our products and want to gain in-depth knowledge in specific areas.

The basic level Discovery Training is a prerequisite for all course. For the Master Classes, technical courses and working experience with SDL Tridion products are required. Experienced consultants with relevant project experience tutor all courses. They provide an interactive program and exercises in which knowledge and business experience are constantly exchanged.

## R5 Technical Training

This training is designed for developers, technical consultants and technical support staff, who work or plan to work with R5.

The training goal is to provide technical consultants with the required technical knowledge of R5 and experience using the system through practical exercises. The training focuses on the design and development of XML Schemas and templating, while also looking at the event system and the workflow. Next to this, an overview of the other software components within R5 is provided. After this training, participants should:

- Be able to implement simple sites with R5
- Possess a clear awareness of the more complex possibilities of the system
- Possess a complete overview of the R5 suite and the Training Curriculum

## Training brief: R5 Technical Training

### Prerequisites

For this course several technical skills are required such as HTML and XML, VB Script, ASP and general programming experience. The R5 Discovery Training is a prerequisite for this course.

### Training method

During the training the participant will rebuild a Web site. First they will be shown how the Web site is organized and managed with the content management system.

They will then add content and pages in order to understand the content management principles behind it. After this hands-on content management exercise they will replace the content management database and rebuild the site in an empty database, step by step.

During the training a number of more theoretical exercises/presentations will be given to inform participants about the more advanced possibilities of the system, additional products and other training options. You can also expect:

- Three day training
- Classroom instruction
- One development server per two trainees
- Slides and exercises
- Training manual with hand out of slides and relevant documentation
- Standard ten participants per one trainer
